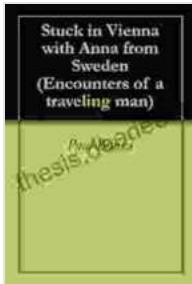


# Stuck In Vienna With Anna From Sweden: Encounters Of Traveling Man

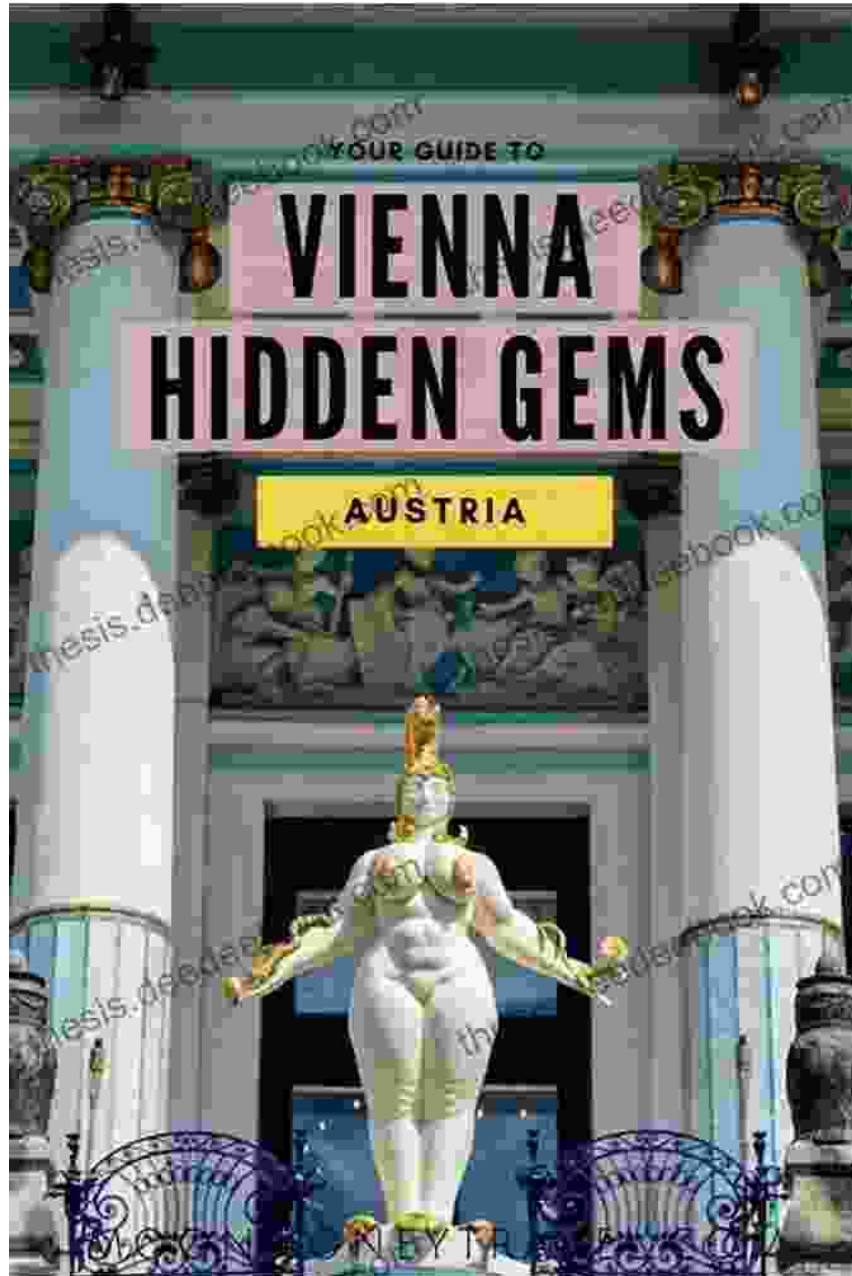

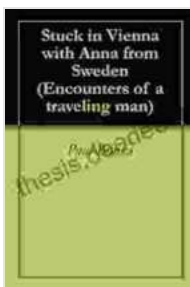

To all the Anna's we meet along the way, may our journeys be filled with unexpected adventures, profound connections, and memories that last a lifetime.

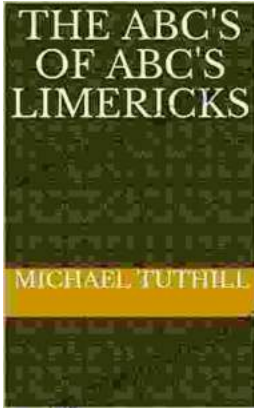


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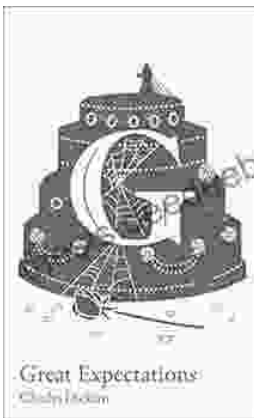
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
